At HopeWell, however, we are proud to say that we consciously live our mission every day. It is at the core of our work—individually and as an institution.



Some of that support may come directly through relationships formed at HopeWell and others may develop as we provide people with the information and tools for enhancing the support that may already exist around them.

Creating a Community

HopeWell is a place where people whose lives have been forever altered by a cancer diagnosis can find a welcoming community of support and hope. At HopeWell, everyone understands the cancer experience: the challenges and opportunities, the setbacks and the triumphs. HopeWell's programs are designed to facilitate meaningful connections that value inclusiveness, integrity and compassion.

Support Groups

A cancer diagnosis brings new feelings, worries and concerns into the lives of both the person with cancer and those who love and support them.

A support group provides a setting where people can talk about the impact of a cancer diagnosis with others in similar situations... people who immediately understand.

The support of a group can help people feel less isolated and stressed, and improve the quality of their lives. Cancer support groups can also promote sharing of the most current information regarding treatment options and research.

All HopeWell's programs are open to people with cancer at any stage: newly-diagnosed, in treatment, post-treatment or living with cancer as a chronic condition. Survivors are welcome at any time.

Kids Circle and Teen Circle

Our Kids Circle/Teen Circle programs piloted a new approach in 2011, one that allowed families coping with cancer to communicate and connect without saying a word.

At the suggestion of parents, we brought the stress reduction benefits of our yoga and meditation classes to our Kids Circle / Teen Circle families.

Instructor Sharon Calvano explains how these classes help children and teens coping with a cancer diagnosis in the home. "Families living with cancer really need both verbal and non-verbal communication skills. This class gives them real tools that travel with them, whether waiting for Mom or Dad's next scan results or preparing for a test at school. They know how to center themselves, breathe and lower their stress level and they understand why that works."

Mind, Body, Spirit

HopeWell’s Mind, Body, Spirit classes offer various approaches to stress reduction. Yoga’s gentle movements can improve balance and strength and lessen the impact of side effects for people coping with cancer. Meditation can offer new ways for people to shift their focus from their disease to the entirety of their being.

HopeWell’s Mindfulness Meditation instructor Gina Sager, MD, RYT agrees. “You can’t change the circumstances of your illness, but you can change your relationship to your diagnosis,” says Sager.

We often hear that taking a Mind, Body, Spirit class at HopeWell just “feels good.” Our peaceful setting, experienced instructors and a sense of camaraderie and community helps participants begin to “pay attention” to what matters most to them... an important skill not only during treatment but for the ups and downs of everyday life.

Enjoying the Gift of Nature

“Time spent outdoors can be both soothing and restorative,” says Program Director Carole Sharp. “Our job was to begin to create programs that encouraged our community to enjoy our grounds in a safe and structured way.”

New programs were added in 2011, such as Backyard Birding and nature walks. Mindfulness Meditation and Kids Circle/Teen Circle have spent time outside—exploring, walking and playing.

HopeWell’s volunteer ornithologist and participants have identified over 60 species of birds and 15 types of butterflies that live, or fly through, HopeWell’s property.

Providing Support by Exchanging Information

People with cancer are bombarded with information from a wide range of sources. HopeWell's programs provide a forum to discuss, share and learn from others about life with cancer. HopeWell offers experienced facilitators and instructors, as well as a community of experts who freely offer their knowledge while encouraging an open dialogue. The collective wisdom of the HopeWell community is a powerful source of support.

In 2011, HopeWell hosted 38 guest speakers through the House Calls Speaker Series. Dr. Dawn Leonard reflects on her experience...



I was honored to have the opportunity to speak with the Breast Cancer Support Group at HopeWell Cancer Support as part of the House Calls Speaker series. The small-group, informal setting was ideal for a more intimate, open and honest discussion with a group of women facing breast cancer challenges. In addition to providing information on current therapy trends, we were able to tailor the discussion to address

the questions that each participant had. They made the task so much easier as they were able to call on personal experiences to augment the clinical information I was sharing. We got so involved in our discussion that time flew by and we needed a reminder to "wrap it up." It was a beautiful, unforgettable experience.

Training Medical Professionals

HopeWell offers a unique opportunity for learning to occur between and among oncology professionals and people with cancer and their families. Our guest speakers enjoy the opportunity to share their expertise in a casual, open setting—and participants are able to ask questions they might never have had the chance to discuss with their own physician.

In 2011, HopeWell recognized our important role as a resource for those healthcare providers, expertise we have gleaned from over 17 years of experience.

As an approved sponsor of Continuing Education programs for Social Workers in Maryland, HopeWell now offers educational opportunities for professionals to come to HopeWell and discuss, explore, and examine the impact of cancer on the individual and strategies for how to help. In addition, we focus on the importance of caring for oneself as a healthcare professional—a topic often overlooked.

Extending our Reach Online, and through Social Media

In late 2009, HopeWell introduced an all-new, web-site: www.hopewellcancersupport.org. The new site provides more information and offers an interactive calendar and improved online giving capability.

This year, HopeWell's communications efforts centered around driving traffic to the new site, by extending our reach through social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter and YouTube.

Data analysis showed that during the year covered by this Annual Report, we had over 16,500 visits to the new site and 8,375 unique visitors.

We also utilized Facebook and Twitter, resulting in significant growth both in the number of followers and reliable content for our community members.

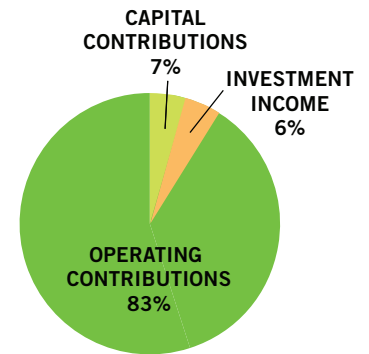

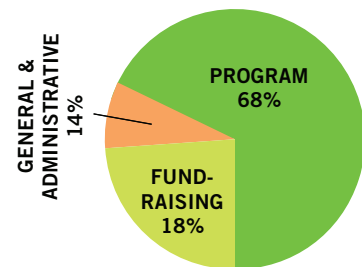
