



Frequently Asked Questions About HopeWell Cancer Support

- Q. Is there a charge to participate in HopeWell’s programs and services?**
A. HopeWell’s support community is available at no cost for adults with cancer at any stage – in treatment, long term survivorship, or facing the end of life – as well as family members, including children, teens, and caregivers.
- Q. Do I need to come to HopeWell in person to participate?**
A. Most of our programs are hybrid or virtual. Although we encourage in-person participation, we know many people are immunocompromised and would prefer to be in the comfort of their home or join in while getting treatment at a medical facility.
- Q. Do you have support groups for all types of cancer?**
A. We do not currently have a support group for every type of cancer. However, we have a support group that is applicable to any type of cancer.
- Q. How is HopeWell supported?**
A. We are fortunate to receive financial support from numerous individuals, corporations, and foundations. It is because of this generosity that we do not have to charge our participants.
- Q. Can my caregiver attend sessions with me?**
A. Absolutely yes! Many of our programs and services extend to your personal network of family members, including children, and other loved ones who are providing you support.
- Q. Do you have a program for families, including children?**
A. Our Family Circle Program is led by professional, certified staff who specialize in working with children affected by the cancer diagnosis of an adult loved one.
- Q. Does HopeWell offer support and services for young adults?**
A. We have a young adults program for people under forty diagnosed with cancer, helping you realize you are not alone when navigating cancer, and helping you problem-solve issues particularly pertinent to cancer at a young age.
- Q. How do I get started as a HopeWell participant?**
